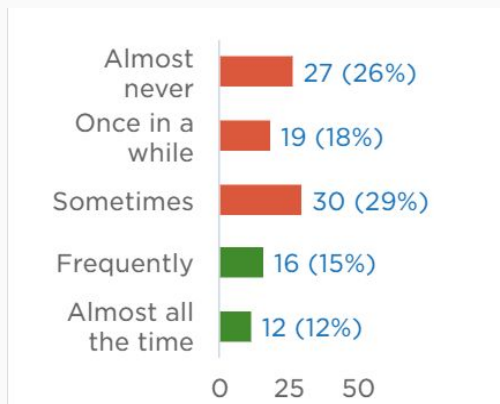
Purpose

Establish and maintain inspiring and empowering relationships so that student learning is maximized through high expectations and consistent staff interventions for all students.

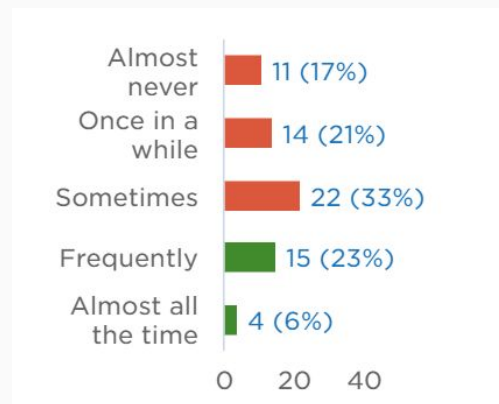
GAIN Data
