There is one important change to our dress code policy for this school year. **Students are allowed to wear their spirit shirts in place of a uniform shirt. This includes GLA shirts or other community partner apparel.**

**All other dress for success policies will remain the same.**

**Warm Weather Items**

- **Shirts**
  - Type: collared button down or polo shirt, long or short sleeved, undershirt can be worn under approved shirt
  - Colors: any solid color
  - Logo: small logo acceptable (up to 2 inches); school logo is permitted
  - **Spirit wear shirts (GLA, sports, programs, or community partners)**
- **Shorts (including capris, skirts, dresses)**
  - Type: uniform style
  - Length: knee length
  - Colors: khaki, navy, black
- **Pants**
  - Type: uniform style (worn at natural waist)
  - Colors: khaki, navy or black
- **Footwear:** any closed toe and closed back
- **Headwear:** no hats or other head coverings

**Cool Weather Items (Sweaters and Pullovers)**

- Type: hoodless sweater, vest, zip up fleece, softshell or cardigan worn with a collared button down or polo shirt underneath
- Colors: any solid color
- Logo: small logo acceptable (up to 2 inches); school logo is permitted
